

Good or Bad Feedback - Examples

Each paragraph should have one main idea and that idea goes in the topic sentence.
Your details strongly support your claim that we should recycle newspapers. Where did you find those facts?
Your report was the shortest one in the class. You did not put enough detail in it.
Your report is better than your last one. You made it clear as to what causes deforestation. What would make it better is more about what the long-term effects of deforestation are, for example: global climate change.
This investigation is excellent. Well done!
I did not see anything that addresses Criteria C in your report. Can you tell me what happened?
I really like the infographic that you used to show the benefits of physical activity. You have used it in the relevant section of the essay and supports what you say in that particular paragraph. What prompted you to use this piece of visual information?
This piece of work is not as good as the earlier pieces that you submitted. What is the matter with you?
The argument that you made in your presentation probably would not convince someone to give up smoking. What else could be added to strengthen your argument?
You make some really strong points about what these results show. This would be strengthened even further if you showed the reader where information comes from.
You have not read the question and the response does not address what is required. You really should write the question at the top of the page. It would be worthwhile you re-submitting this.
You did not answer the second part of the question. When you list the combinations in order, you know you have all the possible combinations.
